**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

A Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry is required (ABD must successfully defend by August 15, 2016). Applicants must demonstrate a strong background in Organic Chemistry through academic training and research, and preference will be given to individuals with a demonstrated record of experience in the pharmaceutical industry, including project management.

Candidates selected for in-person interviews must demonstrate their teaching skills by giving a complete lecture on a specified topic in Organic Chemistry, and must also present a research seminar to the Department. Only those candidates whose demonstrated teaching skills meet department standards will be considered as Finalists.
